SectionII INTRODUCTION & INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preamble

DEH is a local NGO, with headquarters in Mogadishu - Somalia, and operating in many parts of the country including Galmudug, Hirshabelle, and SWS states of Somalia. **DEH** has received a grant from **SHF** for the implementation of the Provision of lifesaving nutritional support to communities with high intersectoral severity of needs, that have experienced climatic shocks in Galkayo South

***NB:** Supporting documents and printed literature furnished by the bidder may be in another language, provided they are accompanied by a translation into the language of the procedure (ENGLISH). For the purposes of interpretation of the tender, the language of the procedure will prevail.*



2. Participation

To be eligible for participation in the tender, tenderers must provide all the requested documentation in a timely basis. Tenderers must also prove to the Contracting Authority that they comply with the necessary legal, technical, and financial requirements. DEH reserves the right to ask for documentation.

Tenderers have to declare, under their responsibility, that they do not fall under ineligibility clauses (**annex B**), that all of the items offered have been manufactured in accordance with international rules against exploitation of child labor and gender discrimination (**annex C**). Moreover, tenderers have to declare to treat with confidence any information or documents related to the procedure (**annex D**).

4. Choice criteria

After receiving all the tender offers, the contracting authority will decide the best offer according to the lowest price most technically acceptable offer.

Evaluation shall be conducted as follows:

a) Technical compliance of the offered goods/services.

The following technical criteria will be reviewed for compliance compared to DEH requirements:

- Services offered in the quotation are compliant compared to the requirements in Annex I (Schedule of Requirements).
- Completeness of the Quotation. All Returnable Bidding Forms and other documentation requested have been provided and are complete.

b) Financial Offer:

Price proposal. Please prepare a budget including breakdown of all costs included. **The price will be expressed in USD inclusive of VAT and transport** to DEH office in Galkayo/Adado. Price indicated in the quotation will be considered fixed and valid from the moment of the offer until **3 months (90 days)**; no change of price will be accepted unless if mutually agreed with the contracting authority during the negotiation process, provided that such changes will be duly substantiated in an updated technical proposal.

At any time during the evaluation process DEH may request clarification or further information in writing from Bidders. The Bidder's responses shall not contain any changes regarding the substance, including



the technical and financial part of their quotation. DEH may use such information in interpreting and evaluating the relevant quotation.

5. Deadline for the presentation of the documentation

The offer, dated and signed in original by the tenderer, shall be presented to DEH office in Galkayo, by **25 July 2024** at the following address:

6. General conditions

All correspondence and documents related to the ITB, contracts and reporting shall be written in English. In no circumstances DEH will be liable for damages, whatever their nature (in particular damages for loss of profits) or relationship to the cancellation of the ITB, even if DEH has been advised of the possibility of damages. ***The invitation to procurement does not commit DEH to implement the project announced, and the sign of the contract is bound by the donor financing***

Any dispute shall be referred to the Mogadishu Court (Somalia), provided however that DEH at its own discretion, may elect to waive the competence of the Somali law and the Mogadishu Court to bring an action against the bidder before any court of competent jurisdiction, in the domicile of the bidder itself, the applicable law being the law of the Country of the bidder’s domicile.

This invitation to ITB has been written in English. In case it will be translated in any other language than English, then the English version shall prevail in case of difference of interpretation.

SHF will establish the final amount of the grant and will liquidate it to DEH on completion of the operation on the basis of the expenses presented and declared eligible. No party other than DEH shall derive any rights from the grant or have any claim to its proceeds. Under no circumstances or for no reason whatsoever will DFID entertain any request for indemnity or payment directly submitted by DEH contractors.

Supplier Declarations with Prohibition of Sexual Exploitation and Abuse (PSEA)

All suppliers engaged in business with DEH are required to acknowledge and comply with the DEH PSEA Policy.

Suppliers must provide a written declaration confirming their adherence to the following principles:

1. Commitment to Ethical Conduct

The Supplier acknowledges and agrees to conduct all business activities in a manner that respects human rights, with a strong commitment to preventing and addressing any forms of sexual exploitation and abuse (SEA).

2. Zero Tolerance Policy

The Supplier understands that DEH maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards SEA. The Supplier, its employees, and any subcontractors or agents engaged in fulfilling the contract shall not engage in any form of SEA.

3. Definition of SEA

5. Consequences of Breach

Any breach of this clause by the Supplier, its employees, subcontractors, or agents may result in the immediate termination of the contract and could lead to further legal actions, including but not limited to, being barred from future contracts with DEH.

6. Training and Awareness

The Supplier shall ensure that all employees, subcontractors, and agents are trained on the prohibitions of SEA and are aware of the Supplier's and DEH zero-tolerance policy.
